Alberta Education states, “The aim of senior high school Career and Life Management (CALM) is to enable students to make well-informed, considered decisions and choices in all aspects of their lives and to develop behaviours and attitudes that contribute to the well-being and respect of self and others, now and in the future. CALM is the core course for health literacy at the senior high school level in Alberta.”

In just 9 short days, students will have the option of **attendance or non-attendance-based** learning to complete Career and Life Management, a mandatory Alberta Education graduation requirement course; as well as Job Preparation and Workplace Safety, a pre-requisite for Work Experience, the Registered Apprenticeship Program and Green Certificate. This allows students to successfully complete 5 credits.

This course is open to any grade 10-12 high school students who wants to jump start their high school education or simply needs to secure this course for graduation. This course will be offered over a 9-day period **beginning July 2** and **concluding July 12** or sooner depending on the student’s self-motivation and efficiency. There is no final exam for this course.
