Alberta Education states, “The aim of senior high school Career and Life Management (CALM) is to enable students to make well-informed, considered decisions and choices in all aspects of their lives and to develop behaviours and attitudes that contribute to the well-being and respect of self and others, now and in the future. CALM is the core course for health literacy at the senior high school level in Alberta.”

In just 9 short days, students will have the option of attendance or non-attendance based learning to complete Career and Life Management, a mandatory Alberta Education graduation requirement course. Both Job Preparation and Workplace Safety- a prerequisite for Work Experience, Registered Apprenticeship Program and Green Certificate, allowing students to successfully complete 5 credits.

This course is open to any grade 10-12 high school students who wants to jump start their high school education or simply needs to secure this course for graduation.

4619 50 Avenue in Wetaskiwin will provide a classroom and marking assignments. This course will be offered over a 9 day period beginning July 2 and concluding on July 12, 2019.**
